<u>Memorial Day Events at</u> <u>State Veterans Cemeteries in Fernley and Boulder City</u>

(Fernley & Boulder City, Nev.) – Mark your calendar to attend the upcoming Memorial Day events at both the Southern and Northern Nevada Veterans Memorial Cemeteries. This year, Memorial Day is Monday, May 29, 2023.

The timeline for the Memorial Day weekend is as follows:

Flag-In - Saturday, May 27th

This year, Flag-In volunteers will receive a commemorative pin marking the 80th Anniversary of NDVS, while supplies last. Only one pin per person, so if you don't want to miss out on receiving this special gift, make sure you arrive early or on time as pins will be handed out on a first come, first served basis.

- **South:** 7:00 a.m. at the Southern Nevada Veterans Memorial Cemetery. Volunteers are asked to assemble in the Chapel Courtyard area.
- North: 8:30 a.m. at the Northern Nevada Veterans Memorial Cemetery. Volunteers are asked to assemble in the paved area at the pavilion.

Special Forces Ceremony – Sunday, May 28th

• South ONLY: 10:00 a.m. Assemble near the fountain in the Memorial Garden.

Memorial Day Ceremony – Monday, May 29th

- **South:** 1:00 p.m. at Southern Nevada Veterans Memorial Cemetery. Give yourself time for parking!
- North: 11:00 a.m. at the Northern Nevada Veterans Memorial Cemetery.

The Southern Nevada Veterans Memorial Cemetery is located at 1900 Veterans Memorial Drive in Boulder City, Nevada.

The Northern Nevada Veterans Memorial Cemetery is located at 14 Veteran's Way in Fernley, Nevada. Memorial Day events at NNVMC are held in partnership with the Nevada Veterans Coalition.
