Special Ceremony to Honor Veteran of the Month Recipients

(Carson City, Nev.) – There will be a ceremony to honor northern Nevada recipients of the Veteran of the Month (VOM) in Old Assembly Chambers, located on the second floor of the Nevada State Capitol Building, 101 North Carson Street in Carson City on Friday, June 30, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. Media members are encouraged to attend.

Our congratulations go out to James Hanson and William Grey as they were selected as VOM recipients for the months of July and August 2023.

Mr. Hanson is a U.S. Army veteran. He was selected as the July 2023 VOM. His volunteer service accolades are too lengthy to list here, but ranges from supporting veterans at Reno's VA and other veteran organizations to helping finance the Northern Nevada Honor Flight program. Mr. Hanson was instrumental in working with other area Vietnam veterans to create the Reno chapter of the Vietnam Veterans of America, Sierra Nevada Chapter 989.

Mr. Grey is also a U.S. Army veteran. He was selected as the August 2023 VOM. Mr. Grey also boast a lengthy list of volunteer activities including holiday efforts that support Nevada Army and Air Guard families and as well as the decoration of the Northern Nevada State Veterans Home in Sparks. He serves as the Vice-Chair on the board of Vietnam Veterans of America, Sierra Nevada Chapter 989.
