YOU CAN RECEIVE YOUR HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA THROUGH THIS SPECIAL PROGRAM

In 2003, during the 72nd Session of the Nevada Legislature, Assembly Bill 52, Operation Recognition, was passed. This bill provides for Nevada School Districts to issue a standard high school diploma to certain veterans. To receive this high school diploma, a veteran must have served in the Armed Forces of the United States during WWII through the Vietnam Era, between the dates of September 16, 1940 and May 7, 1975. A veteran, a guardian of a disabled veteran, or a member of a deceased veteran's family, on behalf of the deceased veteran, may submit an application.

OPERATION RECOGNITION FOR WWII THROUGH VIETNAM ERA VETERANS

HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA FOR VETERANS SERVING BETWEEN SEPTEMBER 16, 1940 AND MAY 7, 1975

Background:

In 2003, during the 72nd Session of the Nevada Legislature, Assembly Bill 52, Operation Recognition, was passed. This bill provides for Nevada School Districts to issue a standard high school diploma to certain veterans. To receive this high school diploma, a veteran must have served in the Armed Forces of the United States during WWII through the Vietnam Era, between the dates of September 16, 1940, and May, 7, 1975. A veteran, a guardian of a disabled veteran, or a member of a deceased veteran's family, on behalf of the deceased veteran, may submit an application.

To Qualify:

• The veteran must have a copy of the certificate of honorable discharge or a copy of the DD Form 214 issued to the veteran.

• The veteran must have attended a secondary school in the state before he left to serve in the Armed Forces of the United States and list the name and the location of the Nevada secondary school where they attended.

Where to Submit the Application:

The application must be submitted to the **Nevada Department of Veteran Services**, **Grant Sawyer**, **555 E. Washington Ave.**, **Rm 3200**, **Las Vegas**, **NV 89101**, accompanied by a copy of the certificate of honorable discharge or a copy of the DD 214 issued to the veteran. If a guardian of a disabled veteran or family member of a deceased veteran submits an application requesting a standard high school diploma, the application must be accompanied by an affidavit affirming to the best of his/her knowledge that the disabled or deceased veteran attended a secondary school in this state before he/she left to serve in the Armed Forces of the United States and list the name and location of the Nevada secondary school.

Approval Process of Application:

The Nevada Department of Veterans Services will approve the application and forward it to the school district indicated on the application. The school district will notify the veteran of the approval and will arrange to present the high school diploma during one of the following as requested by the veteran: **The school district's yearly graduation exercise – or a special ceremony.**

If the veteran chooses to forgo a ceremony, the high school diploma will be mailed directly to them. The Department of Veterans Services will receive a copy of all high school diplomas issued to veterans in this program.
