Governor Lombardo Keynote Speaker at NDVS-Hosted Veterans Day Ceremony

(Las Vegas, Nev.) – The [Nevada Department of Veterans Services](#) (NDVS) will host a Veterans Day Ceremony on **Saturday, November 11, 2023, at 1:30 p.m. at the Nevada State Veterans Memorial, 555 East Washington Avenue**, located outside the Grant Sawyer Building across from the Cashman Center in Las Vegas.

The ceremony will be a celebration of veterans and the men and women currently serving in the U.S. Armed Forces. Nevada Governor Joe Lombardo will serve as the keynote speaker. Lieutenant Governor Stavros Anthony will also be in attendance. Additionally, recipients of the Veteran of the Month and Veteran Supporter of the Month will be recognized.

The public is encouraged to attend this celebration! Since seating is limited, registration is requested by going [HERE](#). Once a reservation is made, no further RSVP is requested, and a printed ticket is not necessary or required to attend.

In addition to members of the public, dignitaries, and elected leaders from local, state and Nevada's Congressional delegation will be in attendance. The location of the Veterans Day Ceremony is on the corner of Las Vegas Boulevard and East Washington Avenue, not far from the downtown Annual Las Vegas Day Parade which begins earlier in the day at 10:00 a.m. The location and timing of the ceremony will make it convenient for the public to attend.
