NDVS Welcomes New Southern Nevada State Veterans Home Administrator

(Las Vegas, Nev.) – The <u>Nevada Department of Veterans Services</u> (NDVS) is pleased to welcome Jennifer "Jeni" Fuller as the new administrator of the <u>Southern Nevada State Veterans Home</u> (SNSVH) in Boulder City, NV. Ms. Fuller assumed the role of administrator immediately.

Ms. Fuller is a familiar face within Nevada's skilled nursing/rehabilitative services community. She has been a registered nurse for more than 30 years and a licensed nursing home administrator in the Silver State for 19 years. Originally from New York, Ms. Fuller moved to Nevada in 1997. She is a graduate of the Maria College School of Nursing in Albany, New York and has also obtained her Bachelor of Science in Psychology.

The SNSVH is a 180-bed facility providing 24/7 skilled nursing and rehabilitative care to eligible veterans, their spouse, and Gold Star parents. A wide array of services and programs are offered including Alzheimer's and dementia care. Residents have greater access to physicians, physical therapy, occupational and speech therapies, mental health care, restorative care, palliative care, hospice care, laboratory, pharmacy, and clinical dietary services. The SNSVH is State-owned and operated, receiving support from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs.
