Governor Lombardo Keynote Speaker at NDVS-Hosted Veterans Day Ceremony

(Las Vegas, Nev.) – The <u>Nevada Department of Veterans Services</u> (NDVS) will host a Veterans Day Ceremony on **Monday**, **November 11**, **2024**, **at 2:00 p.m. at the Southern Nevada State Veterans Home**, **100 Veterans Memorial Drive**, **in Boulder City**.

The ceremony will be a celebration of veterans and the men and women currently serving in the U.S. Armed Forces. Nevada Governor Joe Lombardo will serve as the keynote speaker.

The public is encouraged to attend this celebration! Since seating is limited for the 2:00 p.m. ceremony, registration is requested by going <u>HERE</u>. Once a reservation is made, no further RSVP is requested, and a printed ticket is not necessary to attend.

Earlier in the day, there will be a community parade in front of the SNSVH beginning at 9:00 a.m. featuring friends and supporters including the Boulder City Fire and Police Departments!

The parade will be followed by a Classic Car Show, courtesy of the Boulder City Cruisin Association. The "Cruise-in with Our Veterans" car show will be on display until noon. Registration for the morning events is not requested. For the parade and car show, simply show up and join the fun.
