## **VETERAN OF THE MONTH (VOM) NOMINATION GUIDELINES**

- 1. The nominee must be a living resident of Nevada.
- 2. The nominee must have received a discharge under honorable conditions from the U.S. Armed Forces.
- 3. Nominees will be selected for significant contributions made at the local, state and/or national level and by excellence achieved through going above and beyond the call of duty, specifically with respect to VOLUNTEER WORK in support of veterans, military and community.
- 4. Nominations will be evaluated on the scope and impact of a nominee's achievements and the extent to which the nominee's efforts benefit and provide inspiration to their community and other veterans.
- 5. Please document significant achievements and accomplishments in the following three areas on the Veteran of the Month Nominee Contributions Sheet:
- Volunteer support to Veterans
- Volunteer support to Military
- Volunteer support to Community
- 6. Nominations will be reviewed, and the recipients will be ultimately chosen by the Veterans Services Commission (VSC). Nominations are accepted at all times throughout the year.
