Our Cemeteries

In 1978, Congress established the State Cemetery program to complement the Department of Veterans Affairs National Cemetery Administration (NCA) system. Under this program, the federal government provides financial assistance to states that desire to construct and operate a State Veterans Cemetery.

In 1987, the Nevada State Legislature approved funding for two such cemeteries, one located in Northern Nevada (Fernley) and one in Southern Nevada (Boulder City). Both Nevada Cemeteries opened in 1990 under the administration of the former Nevada Commission for Veterans Affairs, now the Nevada Department of Veterans Services.

Services Offered

Funeral services in our Veterans Memorial Cemeteries are conducted either in our Pavilion or indoor facility. The cemeteries do not provide clergy; clergy must be arranged by your funeral director or by a family member. No fee is charged for the use of the service facility. Moreover, the cemeteries do not provide military honors. Military honors, if so desired, must be arranged in advance by the family or their representatives. The cemetery staff can assist by providing the telephone numbers and addresses of organizations that may assist in providing honors.

Honoring America's Heroes

The last Monday of May is set aside by our nation to remember those who have served in protecting our country's freedom. Each Memorial Day, in conjunction with veterans service organizations, the Nevada Veterans Memorial Cemeteries plan and host Memorial Day ceremonies. We welcome volunteers for Flag-In on the Saturday prior to Memorial Day and Wreaths Across America, on the second or third Saturday in December.

Eligibility

Eligibility for burial is similar to the criteria used by the Department of Veterans Affairs National Cemetery Administration. However, the cemetery is responsible for verifying eligibility and should be contacted directly for specifics by calling the applicable burial grounds. Veterans are buried at the Nevada Veterans Memorial Cemeteries at no charge. This includes the cemetery plot, opening and closing, concrete vault, markers, and perpetual care. A \$450 fee (subject to change) is charged for the burial of a spouse or eligible dependent. Mortuary fees are not included.
